	The schedule of recommendations from the meeting held on 31 March 2014 were received and noted.	NOTED
021	WEST SUFFOLK SIX POINT PLAN FOR JOBS AND GROWTH - UPDATE (VERBAL)	
	The Steering Group received and noted a presentation (attached) from the Head of Economic Development and Growth which provided an update on the progress which had been made on the actions contained within the West Suffolk Six Point Plan for Jobs and Growth.	NOTED
	A discussion was held on a range of issues arising from the presentation, which included:	
	(a) The establishment of the West Suffolk Business Forum had been effective and now also allowed countywide initiatives to be incorporated into West Suffolk as well.	
	(b) Officers had undertaken three themed leaflet drops by visiting businesses on the business parks. A Member stated that some businesses had contacted him and had not appreciated these visits, as it was considered to be non-productive, based on previous experience working with the Council. The Officer acknowledged and accepted that this type of initiative may not necessarily be welcomed by all businesses.	
	It was noted for the future, that Ward Members would be informed when the Growth officers were due to be visiting businesses within their Wards, so that they were aware that visits were taking place. It was also acknowledged that Officers and Ward Members needed to closely liaise to ensure awareness of any local issues within that particular area.	
	(c) West Suffolk had hosted the New Anglia LEP Board meeting on 19 June 2014 in Bury St Edmunds. Officers considered that this had been a very successful initiative. Members requested for an invitation to also be extended to the Greater Cambridge/Greater Peterborough LEP to hold their board meeting within West Suffolk.	
	(d) Work was currently being undertaken on the	

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	Business Festival which was to be held from 1 to 10 October 2014. Further information would be provided to the next meeting of the Group.	
	(e) An Events Calendar, which set out activities and events, had now been established and was used to inform social media and website content. However, it was considered that Members may also find this information useful. Therefore, Officers would ensure that this calendar was also accessible by Members.	
	Officers were commended on the progress being made, however, to be able to achieve some of the initiatives identified it was acknowledged that there needed to be improved co-ordination between the County and District/Borough councils. The Chairman considered that some progress was being made, an example being that regular meetings were now being held with Suffolk County Council Economic Development Officers. Also more joined-up work was now taking place within West Suffolk between the services of Housing, Planning and Economic Development.

	The Steering Group received and noted a presentation (attached) from the Principal Growth Officer on the production of an inward investment pack. This would be a West Suffolk 'fact pack' to be made available for businesses which were relocating or starting up. 023	WEST SUFFOLK HOUSING STRATEGY (VERBAL)	
	The Steering Group received and noted a verbal report from the Public Health and Housing Manager (on behalf of the Housing Development and Strategy Manager) on the timescale and process for the adoption of the West Suffolk Housing Strategy.	NOTED
	The Strategy was designed to develop and supply a range of housing options across the private sector, the	

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	private rented market and social/affordable housing, ensuring that all tenures would provide sustainable and suitable homes for the residents of West Suffolk.	
	The Strategy would be subject to a six week consultation process. The consultation document was due to be considered by both Cabinets on 24 June 2014 (SEBC) and 15 July 2014 (FHDC), with the consultation process starting after.	
	As part of this consultation process, various briefing sessions would be held. Members would also be given the opportunity to comment on the document, prior to adoption by both Cabinets on 2 September 2014 (SEBC) and 16 September 2014 (FHDC).
