

Bury St Edmunds Area Working Party 4 January 2011

Suffolk County Council Local Transport Plan

Suffolk County Council is required by the government to produce a Local Transport Plan (LTP). The current plan covers the period from 2006 to 2011 and work to develop a new one is underway. Suffolk's third LTP will have a 20 year strategy and a short, medium and long term implementation plan. The County Council's priorities for transport are focussed on the high level aims of:-

- (a) promoting economic recovery and growth;
- (b) reducing the climate change impacts of transport;
- (c) supporting education and skills; and
- (d) improving health outcomes.

In preparing the new plan the County Council recognises that there are differences in development needs across Suffolk and wants this plan to recognise that with local strategies for the main towns.

The County Council will be consulting partners and stakeholders on a draft LTP early in 2011, including the Borough Council. In this respect, an officer from the County Council will make a presentation on the draft LTP to the Working Party.

The Working Party is asked for comments.
