5. Petition: 'Make the King's Road Area Safe'

Notification has been received that the organisers of a petition containing over 130 signatures wish to present it at this meeting of the Working Party. In accordance with Part 4, Rules of Procedure, of the Council's Constitution, if petitioners so wish, a petition containing not less than 20 signatures may be presented to the Chairman of the appropriate body. When a petition is considered by that body then a representative of the petitioners may speak at the meeting for not more than three minutes.

A serious collision occurred at the junction of Kings Road and Albert Crescent on Saturday 8 January 2011 when a car left the carriageway and struck two pedestrians walking on the footway. The petition raises a number of concerns regarding safety, traffic flow and footway widths.

Officers have met with the Police to discuss their investigation of the incident. A speed survey has also been undertaken in Kings Road near the bend and the outcome will be orally reported to the Working Party.

Kings Road between Parkway and Albert Crescent is currently subjected to a waiting restriction between 9.00 am and 5.00 pm Monday to Saturday. Officers of St Edmundsbury and Suffolk County Council have discussed the possibility of allowing some parking in sections of this length of Kings Road at all times and introducing a 'no waiting at any time' restriction to the rest of this section of road. This would have the benefit of slowing traffic and deterring some unnecessary use of this road as a through route. The installation of bollards in front of number 1 Albert Crescent is also proposed.

In view of the impending transfer of the highway management responsibilities to Suffolk County Council this would be a matter for them to pursue, as would the consideration of other wider traffic management issues raised in the petition.
