

Bury St Edmunds Area Working Party 9 July 2012

Highways Update

1. Drainage

- 1.1 The recent spells of extremely wet weather have highlighted areas of the town where highway drainage has proved to be inadequate. In some cases problems have been easily resolved by cleaning out the existing drainage system, but in some instances the problem is more intractable. The drainage issues in the following locations are being dealt with as a priority:-
 - (a) Fornham Road, north of A14 flyover;
 - (b) Oswyn Close; and
 - (c) Salisbury Green.

2. Neighbourhood Parking Schemes

- 2.1 Investigation has recently been completed into the establishment of a residents' parking scheme in the lay-by in Out Risbygate opposite St Peter's Pit. Residents are supportive of introducing a scheme and by a slim margin of this being an extension to the adjacent Zone H. It is planned to introduce this to coincide with the renewal of Zone H permits on 1 September 2012.
- 2.2 Work is to start shortly on the investigation of parking issues in two more substantial areas of the town. These are the areas in the vicinity of the east end of Hospital Road and in the Springfield Road/Grove Road areas. Plans of the areas to be investigated are shown at Appendix A to the report.

3. Traffic Regulation Order Review


3.1 The current list of locations where parking issues are being investigated is shown at Appendix B.
