Minutes of the Meeting held 20 March 2009	Service Level Agreements	The Joint Committee resolved at its meeting on 20 March 2009 to extend the two Service Level Agreements for vehicle maintenance and A14/A11 cleansing for a further 12 months subject to any additional costs being presented to the Joint committee for approval. As a consequence the following revised charges were recommended for approval for the Budget Year 2009/2010:-
		(a) Vehicle Maintenance
		Fixed annual charge to Forest Heath District Council to increase from £41,784 per annum to £43,032. Hourly rates for fitters to increase to £45.76 for standard hours and £49.10 for overtime hours.
		(b) A14/A11 Cleansing
		Monthly charge to Forest Heath District Council to increase from £1927.08 per month to £1984.89 per month.
