1. Flood Awareness – Information for Householders (Report A670)

RECOMMENDED:-

That, the draft letter attached as Appendix A to Report A670 be approved and sent to those properties identified.

On 20 October 2009 the Domestic Flood Protection Policy and Strategy (Report A259 refers) was adopted. The Strategy involved completing certain tasks by agreed timelines, and the first of these was to communicate the key messages to the general public. This task was achieved by including an article in Community Spirit. A further action point was that within a year, Suffolk communities at risk of flooding would be made aware of the available advice and information to improve domestic flood protection arrangements. Properties at risk of flooding have been identified by overlaying the Environment Agency flood map onto an OS map.
