Haverhill Vision 2031: Recommendations from the Haverhill Area Working Party: 9 May 2013 (May13/01)

Amendments to the recommendations provided in the original Cabinet Report D378 have been proposed following the distribution of Report D368 and following due consideration by the Haverhill Area Working Party. For ease of reference, changes to text are shown underlined.

1. Haverhill Vision 2031: Submission Version Consultation (Report D368)

RECOMMENDED:

That, subject to the approval of full Council:

- (1) the Haverhill Vision 2031 submission document (Appendix 2), Policies Map Book (Appendix 6), Sustainability Appraisal (Appendix 7), and the Habitat Regulations (Screening) Assessment (Appendix 8), as contained in Report D368, be approved for public consultation subject to the following amendment being included at Appendix 2:
 - (i) Page 67, 15.4b replace 'Enhance the High Street' with 'Enhance the High Street, including the pedestrian environment';
- (2) in accordance with the Council's Concept Statement Protocol, the North East Haverhill Concept Statement (Appendix 5 to Report D368) be adopted;
- (3) the Draft Haverhill Infrastructure Delivery Plan (Appendix 9 to Report D368) be approved for consultation, subject to the following amendment being included:

- (i) Page 13, para 6.3, line 9, insert the word 'not' between 'could' and 'be'; and
- (4) delegated authority be given to the Head of Planning and Regulatory Services, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Transport and Planning, to make any necessary minor typographical, grammatical or similar textual changes to the draft Haverhill Vision and the Draft Infrastructure Delivery Plan prior to publication for consultation purposes.

Report D368, which has been previously circulated in hard copy to all Members of the Council, presents the latest version of the Haverhill Vision 2031 submission document, and supporting documents, for approval for consultation prior to submission to the Secretary of State. Consultation took place commencing March 2012 on the 'Haverhill Vision preferred options' and this submission version seeks to comment upon, and respond to where appropriate, the representations received in response to the earlier consultation.

It is considered that the submission version is greatly improved as a result of both the earlier consultation, and as a result of an assessment against the content of the Government's March 2012 published National Planning Policy Framework. As a result the Haverhill Area Working Party has been asked to recommend to Cabinet that this Haverhill Vision 2031 submission document be approved for consultation to commence in June 2013.

(The contents of this item will be considered alongside the Cabinet's discussion on Report D376, 'Vision 2031: Recommendations from the Sustainable Development Working Party: 14 May 2013', which also considered the Haverhill Vision 2031 document.)
