Representation on Outside Bodies: Annual Report

1. Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 On 29 November 2007 the Panel considered Report Y376 concerning the requirement that an Annual Report for the 2006/2007 financial year be compiled from the reports of the Borough Council's representatives on outside bodies. However, due to the number of forms returned from the representatives on outside bodies it was considered that a full report to Council would be inappropriate. Therefore, the Panel considered what actions should be taken in respect of 2006/2007 and for 2007/2008 to ensure that Annual Reports were produced.
- 1.2 The Panel recommended the following to Council and, on 11 December 2007 Council approved that:-
 - (1) no Annual Report be produced for 2006/2007 but that the returns received can be examined by any Member wishing to see them;
 - (2) the Panel examine the reporting arrangements for Representatives on Outside Bodies and whether the Annual Report form requires amending; and
 - (3) when considering the reporting arrangements, the Panel also consider whether Borough Council representatives are still required on all the outside bodies.
- 1.3 Attached as Appendix A is the list of reports that should be received in the 2007/2008 reporting Year.

2. Report Form

- 2.1 In accordance with the wishes of the Panel, the Annual Report form to be completed by the representatives has been reviewed by the Chairman and Vice Chairman. The amended form is attached as Appendix B.
- 2.2 The Council considers that it is imperative that there is a formal feedback from the representatives on outside bodies in order that a decision can be taken as to whether to continue with the appointment. All annual reports listed in Appendix A are required to be returned in order to facilitate this process. Therefore, it is suggested that the draft letter attached as Appendix C is sent to all representatives to accompany the Annual Report form.

3. Recommendations

3.1 It is **RECOMMENDED** that the Annual Report form, attached as Appendix B to Report Y550, and the accompanying letter, attached as Appendix C to Report Y550 be sent to Representatives on Outside Bodies as detailed in Appendix A to Report Y550.
