Representation on Outside Bodies: Annual Report 2007/2008

1. Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 On 12 February 2008 the Panel considered reporting arrangements for the 2007/2008 financial year from the representatives on outside bodies.
- 1.2 The Panel recommended the following to Council and, on 26 February 2008 Council approved (Minute 89 (C) (1) refers) that:-

'the Annual Report form attached as Appendix B to Report Y550, and the accompanying letter attached as Appendix C to Report Y550 be sent to representatives on outside bodies as detailed in Appendix A to Report Y550.'

1.3 Attached as Appendix A to this report is a copy of the Annual Report form and Appendix B is the list of representatives who received a request to complete the form.

2. Forms Returned

- 2.1 Appendix B has been annotated to record those forms that have been returned. However, circumstances have changed in respect of some organisations and, therefore, a form is not now required. These have been annotated N/A on the appendix.
- 2.2 Of 43 forms requested, 33 have been received, 5 are now not required and 5 (12%) have not been returned.

3. Annual Report 2007/2008: Summary of Key Points Raised

- 3.1 The aims of the Annual Report are to summarise any issues arising from the individual reports, including those instances when it is not thought appropriate to continue appointing a representative and to summarise achievements of each organisation which could be attached as an appendix to the report.
- 3.2 No return recommended that the Council should no longer be represented on an outside body.
- 3.3 Representatives on the Community Associations consider it appropriate for all Ward Members to attend the meetings.

- 3.4 There was overwhelming support for the work of Safer Neighbourhood Teams and the representation allocated by the Council.
- 3.5 It was suggested that consideration should be given to reviewing the structure and composition of the West Stow Anglo Saxon Village Trust.
- 3.6 It was suggested that consideration should be given to reducing the representation on the Clare Country Park from 2 to 1 Members and on the Havebury Housing Partnership Performance Panel from 3 to 2 Members.
- 3.7 It was suggested that as Councillor Marks represents the County Council on the Suffolk Rail Policy Group he also represents the Borough Council.

4. Recommendations

- 4.1 It is **RECOMMENDED** that the Panel:-
 - (a) confirms the format and contents of the Annual Report to Council; and
 - (b) considers that all forms returned by the Council's representatives can be viewed on the Intranet under 'Members' Corner'.
