Rural Areas Community Initiatives Fund: Application for Project Funding: 2010/2011

1. Introduction

1.1. An application was received from Stanton Football Club within two weeks of preparing the reports for this scheduled Grant Working Party meeting. In accordance with the Grants Policy, this application will not go through the usual email voting system and will form the basis of this report.

2. Financial Background

- 2.1 The current budget available for the Rural Areas Community Initiatives Fund is £22,176.68.
- 2.2 Financial details of the Rural Areas Community Initiatives Fund are attached as Appendix A to this report.

3. Stanton Football Club

- 3.1 Stanton Football Club would like a grant to purchase a good quality second-hand 'Compact Tractor Flail Mower and Front Loader'.
- 3.2 This purchase is necessary because their current household ride-on mower, which is twelve years old, has finally stopped working. The club require a mower that is able to cut the pitch when necessary, plus fertilise and roll the pitch to enable a better standard of football to be played.
- 3.3 The application has been approved by the local Ward Member, Councillor Thorndyke, who fully supports the proposal: 'Stanton Football Club is a longstanding club which has achieved promotion to their premier league and now has to maintain their pitch to a high standard using volunteers and therefore they need machinery which is fit for purpose.'

- 3.4 The project fits the following corporate priorities/objectives:-
 - (a) to improve the safety and well being of the community;
 - (b) to promote the development of strong communities;
 - (c) to improve and protect the health of the community and reduce health inequalities; and
 - (d) to promote the diversity of cultural provision.
- 3.5 The cost of the mower is £2,975 (including VAT since the club cannot reclaim the VAT) and Stanton Football Club have £500 from their own funds, £500 from the Stan Co Co Trust (a local lottery), £600 from Stanton Parish Council, and £700 from Havebury Housing Partnership.
- 3.6 The Grant Scoring Matrix for this application is attached as Appendix B to this report.

4. Recommendation

4.1 It is **RECOMMENDED** that a grant of £675 be awarded to Stanton Football Club towards the purchase of a football pitch mower.
