Chedburgh Parish Council

1. Background

- 1.1 In June 2010, Chedburgh Parish Council applied to the Borough Council for a grant from the Recreation, Village Hall and Play Area Grant Scheme fund to fully refurbish and modernise the village play area at a cost of £46,000 plus VAT. An extract from Report B41 dated 8 June 2010 is attached as Appendix A to the Report to provide details of the complete project.
- 1.2 Details of the current financial situation in respect of the Recreation, Village Hall and Play Area Grant Scheme, including material relating to previously funded projects, is attached for information as Appendix B to the Report. This includes the grant of £7,500 which was allocated to Chedburgh Parish Council following its approval by the Cabinet on 23 June 2010 (Minute 22 (b) refers).
- 1.3 The Parish Council has raised a total of £20,000 to date from their own resources, the Borough Council, Havebury Housing Partnership and its Suffolk County Councillor's Locality Budget plus a small amount received from local donations.

2. Current Situation

- 2.1 Unfortunately, the Parish Council has been unable to secure Big Lottery Funding despite a number of attempts and in addition, applications to a number of other funding avenues have proved disappointing. It has explored loan options to obtain the remaining funding but is loathed to commit to such a large sum.
- The Parish Council has therefore decided to cut back the whole project to a figure of £30,000 plus VAT, which the Parish Council is able to reclaim.
- 2.3 In the current economic climate it is expected that the Parish Council will be able to renegotiate a keen price on the equipment. The Borough Council's Community Funding Officer is helping to locate the balance of the required funding and has put the fundraiser in contact with the Bury St Edmunds Volunteer Centre to attend one of their funding surgeries.
- 2.4 The Borough Council is asked to approve the same level of grant at £7,500 for the smaller project.

3. Considerations and Discussion

- 3.1 The Working Party is asked to consider:-
- 3.1.1 The Parish Council is asking for the same size grant for a project which will now be two thirds the financial size. Should a grant of £7,500 be honoured in view that the money has already been allocated?
- 3.1.2 The Parish Council is allocating £7,500 of its own funds into the project and therefore matching the Borough Council funding. Should the Borough Council retain the size of its funding?
- 3.1.3 With the project now being smaller should the Borough Council reduce its funding proportionally to £5,000? If the application had been received now the officers would have likely recommended a grant of £5,000.
- 3.1.4 The Parish Council will still have a further £10,000 to raise and if the Borough Council reduced its commitment to the project will this in fact cause the whole project to be cancelled?

4. Recommendation

4.1 It is **RECOMMENDED** that although the project has been scaled down from costing a total of £30,000 instead of £46,000, as outlined in Section 2 of Report B498, the grant of £7,500 previously awarded to Chedburgh Parish Council towards the modernisation of its play area be retained.

- 3. Extract from Report B41: Application for Project Funding submitted by Chedburgh Parish Council
- 3.1 Chedburgh Parish Council
- 3.1.1 Chedburgh Parish Council wishes to fully refurbish and modernise the village play area. The existing equipment is old, uninspiring and in need of upgrading to bring it up to modern standards.
- 3.1.2 The Parish Council has carried out an initial survey and meeting to gauge the interest in revamping the play area and its findings have been very positive and supportive by the community.
- 3.1.3 The village play area adjoins the Erskine Centre in Chedburgh in which the Little Teapots Pre-School is located and, therefore, a new play area would be fully used by the pre-school children before and after their sessions, as well as children from a wider catchment area.
- 3.1.4 It has obtained three quotations ranging from £40,000 to almost £68,000 plus VAT. It is confirmed that the Parish Council can reclaim the VAT. A grant scoring matrix in respect of this application is attached as Appendix C.
- 3.1.5 The quote the Parish Council favours is for £46,176 plus VAT, although once it has secured sufficient funding for the project to proceed the exact specification will be finalised by the Parish Council at a public meeting.
- 3.1.6 The Parish Council has allowed £7,560 towards the project and is contacting a number of businesses to gain donations; £100 has been raised so far.
- 3.1.7 It is applying to Havebury Housing Partnership, Waste Recycling Environmental (WREN), its Suffolk County Councillor for Locality Funding and the Big Lottery. None of these potential matchfinders have confirmed any grants at this stage.
- 3.1.8 The Borough Council has received a grant application for £10,000 towards the project. The Ward Member, Councillor Aitkens is fully supportive of the project.

3.1.9 Recommendation

It is **RECOMMENDED** that a grant of £7,500 be awarded to Chedburgh Parish Council towards the cost of modernising of the village play area.
