Queen Street Enhancement Scheme: Proposed Commemorative Plaque

- 1. Purpose of the Report
- 1.1 The purpose of the report is to propose a form of commemorative plaque to mark the completion of the Queen Street Enhancement Scheme.
- 2. Plaque Details
- 2.1 An illustration of a plaque design is shown in Section 2.3. As designed it would be approximately 20cm (8") in diameter and cast in metal. The plaque could set into the paving in a suitable location. The supply costs would be:-

(a) Tooling/pattern £325.00;

(b) Casting in bronze £48.00 each; and (c) Cast iron £35.00 each.

2.2 The officers are seeking feedback from the Haverhill Area Working Party on the suggested plaque design and detailing. Given the length of Queen Street, if two bronze plaques (one for each end of Queen Street) were ordered the total cost would be £421.00 plus installation.

3. Recommendations

3.1 It is **RECOMMENDED** that:-

- (1) the Working Party considers and provides feedback on the submitted design of the proposed commemorative plaque for Queen Street, Haverhill, as illustrated in Section 2.3 of Report A136; and
- the feedback makes reference to the detailing, proposed materials and the number of plaques to be incorporated into Queen Street..
