Traffic Regulation Order: High Street, Haverhill

1. Suffolk County Council has informed officers that in relation to the implementation of a Traffic Regulation Order restricting vehicle access at certain times of the day in the High Street, Haverhill, a Notice will be advertised in the Haverhill Echo on 17 June 2010 following letters dispatched to relevant consultees on 10 June 2010. The consultation period closes on 8 July 2010.
2. As the consultation period closes before the next meeting of the Working Party on 22 July 2010, it is proposed that a letter of support be sent from the Haverhill Area Working Party, the content of which to be finalised by the Head of Property Services and Engineering in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Haverhill and Housing.
3. **Recommendation**
 - 3.1 It is **RECOMMENDED** that the Head of Property Services and Engineering, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Haverhill and Housing, be given delegated authority to finalise a letter of support from the Haverhill Area Working Party to Suffolk County Council (SCC) in respect of SCC's proposal to implement a Traffic Regulation Order restricting vehicle access at certain times of the day in the High Street, Haverhill.
