10. BT Public Payphone Removal Consultation 2009

A notification has been received from British Telecommunications plc (BT) requesting consideration of their plans to remove 53 payphones, largely of the traditional red form, within the Borough. St. Edmundsbury has consulted with Parish and Community Councils and will formulate a draft decision on each payphone for further consultation. This will be followed by a final decision on all of the phones to be sent to BT by 2 January 2010. A draft decision is due to be advertised on 4 November 2009.

Consideration will be given to the following factors affecting the significance of each payphone: the housing type in the area, the number of households in the area, public call revenue, emergency use and mobile phone coverage. Whilst the visual importance of the phone boxes in their setting is not a valid consideration BT have offered Parish and Community Councils the opportunity to adopt their respective kiosk for retention without the payphone facility for £1.

This notification follows on from a similar one received in 2008 when St. Edmundsbury agreed to the removal of 22 out of 42 phones which were not being used with any significant frequency. Each payphone within this notification will be reviewed individually in accordance with the considerations above and a brief justification for the decision will provided in a report to be presented to Cabinet on 2 December 2009.
