### 4. Haverhill High Street Improvements: Progress

On 1 December 2010, St Edmundsbury Borough Council's Cabinet resolved that:-

'A sum of £750,000 of Growth Area Funding be allocated to the project for Environmental Improvements to the High Street, Haverhill and that approval of detailed design and community consultation and engagements be overseen by the Haverhill Area Working Party.'

Subsequent to this Cabinet decision, the Haverhill Area Working Party has been involved with the development of the High Street Improvement Scheme. On 8 September 2011, the Working Party was advised by Highways Officers from Suffolk County Council that due to issues raised when undertaking the detailed traffic surveys, a revised scheme was now proposed. A detailed discussion was held at that meeting and the Working Party expressed concern regarding a number of issues connected with the proposed design for the new scheme. This culminated in a request to further discuss the design element of the scheme only at a specially arranged meeting with representatives of ONE Haverhill before approving the recommendations contained in Report C137 attached, which was originally considered by the Working Party on 8 September 2011.

A short presentation on the design for the new scheme will be provided at the beginning of the meeting from Highways Officers of Suffolk County Council.

The meeting is requested to **CONSIDER** the proposals for improvements to the High Street in Haverhill, as contained within Report C137, and agree the design for the new scheme for consultation.
