1. Haverhill Area Working Party: 21 November 2013

Whilst Haverhill Area Working Party (HAWP) meetings are usually held in public, there are no public speaking rights.

At her discretion, the Chairman of the HAWP has agreed to allow public speaking on Report E171, *Options for the Cancellation of the Article 4 Direction in Haverhill*, due to be considered by the Working Party on 21 November 2013, in accordance with the strict procedure provided below.

2. When and where is the meeting being held?

3. Speaking at the meeting

There will be a maximum of 30 minutes allowed for public speaking, regardless of the number of speakers. At her discretion, the Chairman of HAWP will agree the amount of time allocated to each speaker dependent on the number of speakers who have registered (see below).

6. When will it be my turn to speak?

When Report E171 has been reached on the agenda, a Borough Council officer will present it to the Working Party. The Chairman will then ask the people who wish to speak to give their presentations one at a time in the order stated in (3) above. There will be no further opportunity to speak.
