Members' Allowances: Comparison of Allowances with Other Local Authorities in Monetary Terms

1. Background

- 1.1 In undertaking its regular review of Members' Allowances the Panel compares the allowances paid by the Borough Council with those paid by other similar local authorities.
- 2. Basic Allowance: Comparison
- 2.1 Attached as Appendix 1 is a comparison of the Borough Council's **basic** allowance with that paid by other similar local authorities.
- 2.2 The comparison shows the latest information obtained from the other local authorities and is analysed over:-
 - (a) other district councils within Suffolk;
 - (b) the Audit Commission's former family cluster. These local authorities have being used as comparitors since the inception of the Borough Council's Members' Allowance Scheme:
 - (c) the current Audit Commission's recommended comparison with 'near neighbours'; and
 - (d) Rural 50 classification authorities used in previous comparisons. The definition of Rural 50 is district councils with at least 50% but less than 80% of their population in settlements and larger market towns.
- 2.3 From the comparison between the basic allowance paid by other local authorities and that paid by the Borough Council of £5,184 per annum (p.a.);

(a) district councils in Suffolk : average £3,915

below SEBC by £1,269 p.a.

(b) family cluster : average £4,802

below SEBC by £382 p.a.

(c) near neighbours : average £4,304

below SEBC by £880 p.a.

(d) Rural 50 classification : average £4,530

below SEBC by £654 p.a.

(e) Overall : average of £4,407 Below SEBC by £777 p.a.
