Further representations made:

- 1. Page 63 additional objections received from residents of nos. 5, 10 and 14 St James Court. The objections are broadly in line with the objection submitted by no.5 St James Court, as detailed on page 63. The objections are on the grounds that the windows will replace 'original' windows, which will not match the existing windows in the block, and will reduce ventilation to the block. In addition, concerns have been raised that the proposed replacement of the rear elevation windows with doors will impact on the private amenity space of all flats.
