Bury St Edmunds – results from Questionnaire

The bar chart percentages correlate to the first question in the questionnaire, which is:

1) Which of the following key issues do you think are the most important to address within the town centre?

39% Encouraging better access into and around the town centre for car users
48% Encouraging better access into and around the town centre for pedetrians, cyclists and those with mobility requirements
41% Encouraging better access into and out of the town centre for public transport
76% Preserving the unique local identity and character of the town centre
52% Making sure the town centre is enjoyable by all sections of the community (including young and older people and people with disablities
52% Making sure there is a good mix of uses (i.e. businesses, shops, hotels, housing) in the town centre
68% Preserving and enhancing the historic buildings and spaces
41% Better walking routes and directions from the train station to the town centre
56% Improving the links between the arc shopping centre and the old town
29% identifying spaces for new businesses, services, offices and leisure and cultural facilities as the town's population grows
46% Providing enhancements to streets, walkways, squares, parks and public spaces
