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A person who wishes to speak must register at least fifteen minutes before the time the meeting is scheduled to start.*

(Note: The maximum time to be set aside for this item is 30 minutes, but if all questions are dealt with sooner, or if there are no questions, the Shadow Council will proceed to the next business.

Each person may ask <u>one</u> question only. A total of <u>five minutes</u> <u>will be allowed for the question to be put and answered.</u> One further question will be allowed arising directly from the reply, <u>provided that the original time limit of five minutes</u> <u>is not exceeded.</u>

<u>Written questions</u> may be submitted by members of the public to the Interim Monitoring Officer <u>no later than 10.00 am on</u> <u>Monday 16 July 2018.</u> The written notification should <u>detail</u> <u>the full question</u> to be asked at the meeting of the Council.)*
