

## APPENDIX C

1. Except for ingress to and egress from the premises, all doors and windows to remain closed during events involving regulated entertainment.
2. The placing of refuse and empty bottles into outside receptacles shall not take place during the night-time hours between 21:00 and 07:00 to minimise disturbance to nearby properties.
3. Ensure that patrons leaving the premises disperse quietly and promptly.
4. Prior to first use of the licensed premises a noise limiter shall be fitted to the musical amplification system and set at a level to the satisfaction of an authorised Environmental Health Officer of West Suffolk Council so as to ensure that no noise nuisance is caused to local residents or businesses. The operational panel of the noise limiter shall then be secured by key or password. No additional sound generating equipment shall be used on the premises without being routed through the sound limiter device.
5. Prior to first use of the licensed premises the sound insulation of the wall / ceiling structure(s) separating the licensed premises from any adjoining residential dwellings shall be enhanced by at least 20dB above the Building Regulations value and, where necessary, additional mitigation measures shall be implemented to contain regulated entertainment and other commercial noise within the licensed premises so as to achieve the internal sound criteria as per BS 8233:2014 'Guidance on sound insulation and noise reduction for buildings' within the adjoining residential dwellings. Enhanced sound insulation measures shall be implemented prior to first use of the licensed premises and thereafter be permanently retained.
