



Bedrock Geology shows Lewes Nodular Chalk Formation. Superficial deposits show Lowestoft Formation. (Taken from Geology Viewer febraury 2024). This is generally understood to be free-draining land and surface water will drain away well.

Floodrisk summary states that River and Sea are very low risk, Surface Water is also deemed to be very low risk.

Foul drainage, sewerage treatment plant, to be set lower than dwelling to allow for gravity fed drainage. Appropriate warning devices installed when emptying is required.

Detail of cavity wall at ground floor level. DPM 150mm above external ground level. To be applied to outer face of inner block work skin, lapped with DPC.

All external doors are min. 150mm above ground level. Front door to be 150mm above 'sunken patio' patio sloped up to door, to fall away from door, as per elevations.
