ANNUAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL</p> <p>1.1 Timing and Business</p> <p>1.1.1 The timing of the Annual Meeting of the Council will be established by the Head of Legal and Democratic Services, following consultation with the Leader of the Council and the Chairman of the Mayoral Advisory Committee, the meeting to be held on the second Thursday following the four yearly elections, or if there are no elections, the third Thursday in May.</p>	<p><u>Part 4 – Rules of Procedure</u></p> <p><u>4a – Council Procedure Rules</u></p> <p>1. ANNUAL MEETING OF THE COUNCIL</p> <p>1.1 Timing and Business</p> <p>The Annual Meeting of the Council will be held:</p> <p>1.1.1 in a year of ordinary elections of councillors to the council on such day within the twenty-one days immediately following the day of retirement of councillors as the council may fix;</p> <p>1.1.2 in any other year, on such day in the month of March, April or May as the council may fix;</p> <p>1.1.3 at such hour as the council may fix.</p>
